


United Way & Community Supports for Employees Impacted by COVID-19

Do you need help filing for unemployment?

United Way's Income Supports coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to help answer your questions and help you through the filing process.

Do you need to find affordable health insurance to replace what you have lost?

Navigators in United Way's Covering Kids and Families Coalition are ready to help you figure out your options and help get you enrolled so that your family is covered. You likely have more options than you realize.

Do you need help figuring out if you now qualify for SNAP (Food Stamps) or need help applying for SNAP?

United Way's Income Supports coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to help answer your questions and help you through the application process.

Are you in need of financial assistance for rent, utilities or childcare due to loss of income?

United Way's Income Supports coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to talk with you and connect you to current assistance available. Remember that new assistance pools are emerging as this crisis unfolds so more options may be available as time goes on.

Do you need help figuring out how to keep your family financially on track during COVID-19 so you can avoid a mountain of unpaid bills when things return to normal?

United Way's Financial coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to work with you to develop a plan to financially weather this crisis and recover asap in the months ahead.

Do you have questions about available supports or options for loans payments you may have (student loan, auto loans or mortgages)?

United Way's Financial coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to help answer questions about what options are available and which should be considered for your families long-term financial well being.

Are you looking for temporary or new employment options while you are laid off?

United Way's Employment coaches in our THRIVE Network are available to work with you on potential options for temporary or long-term employment.
